### **Rules and information**

- Participation is on a first come first serve basis and limited to the first 50 artists. The entry fee is \$25.00 (**\$15.00 Early Bird Special** by June 1, 2011) and is non-refundable. Please make checks payable to BCAC.
- Buying or selling will be the responsibility of the artist and the customer
- Crabtree Nature Center, BCAC, and Dick Blick cannot and will not be held responsible for property of any kind.
- Artist must bring all of their painting and display materials. (easels, tents, etc) Each artist may bring up to two framed paintings (of area landscapes) to be sold at the exhibit. All artist are responsible for displaying their work.
- Artists may arrive for set-up no earlier than 9:30 am.
- Artists must register upon arrival (before setting up) and be completely set up by 10:00 am.
- There is ample parking in the Crabtree public parking lot.

- Artist’s artwork must be labeled with the following information: Artist Name, Title, medium, size, and price.
- Lunch will be provided from 11:30-1:00. Water will be available all day.
- Artists may select their subject. There are many choice sites at the Center to paint.
- There will be no rain date. Every effort will be made to go on with the event during questionable weather. However, the event may be cancelled if the weather is extreme.
- Artists are encouraged to complete their work by 3:00 so work done that day can be exhibited and sold in an auction held from 3:30-5:00.
